Welcome

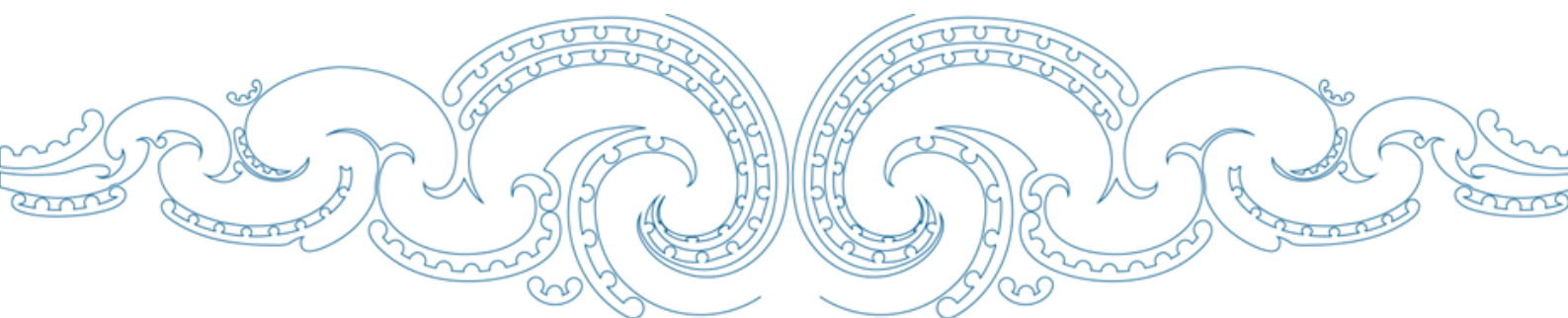
ACC is pleased to present the inaugural ACC Rongoā Māori Conference being held on 22 – 23 May 2024 at the Energy Events Centre in Rotorua. This conference is a celebration of traditional Māori healing and an opportunity for collaboration to support positive health outcomes for whānau and hāpori Māori (Māori communities).

The two-day conference aims to bring together rongoā Māori practitioners and health providers within te ao rongoā (the rongoā community) to whakawhanaunga (build relationships) and grow understanding of traditional Māori healing and its place in Aotearoa New Zealand's health sector.

Ngāti Whakaue has selected this whakataukī (proverb) for the event which forms the foundation of the conference theme:

Ki te kotahi te kākaho ka whati, ki te kāpuia e kore e whati.

If a reed stands alone it will break, if a group of reeds stand together, they are unbreakable.

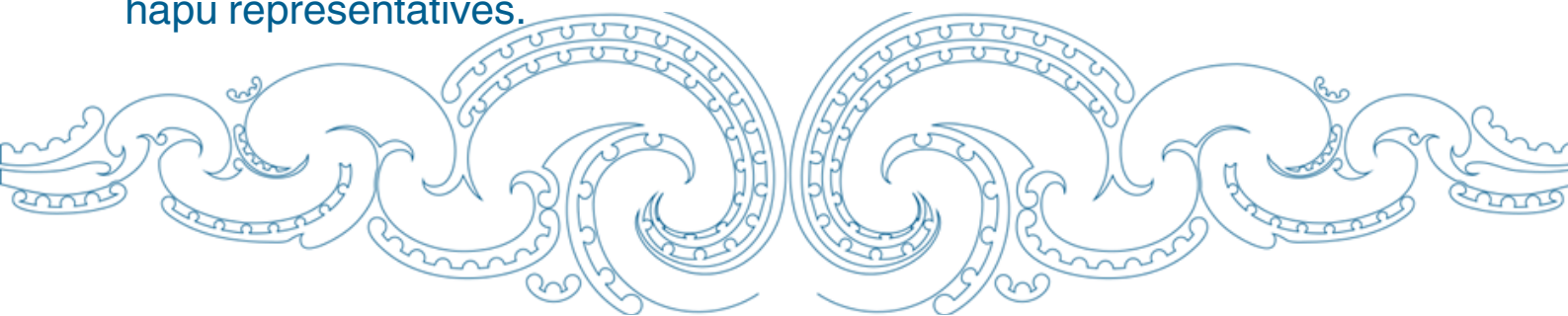

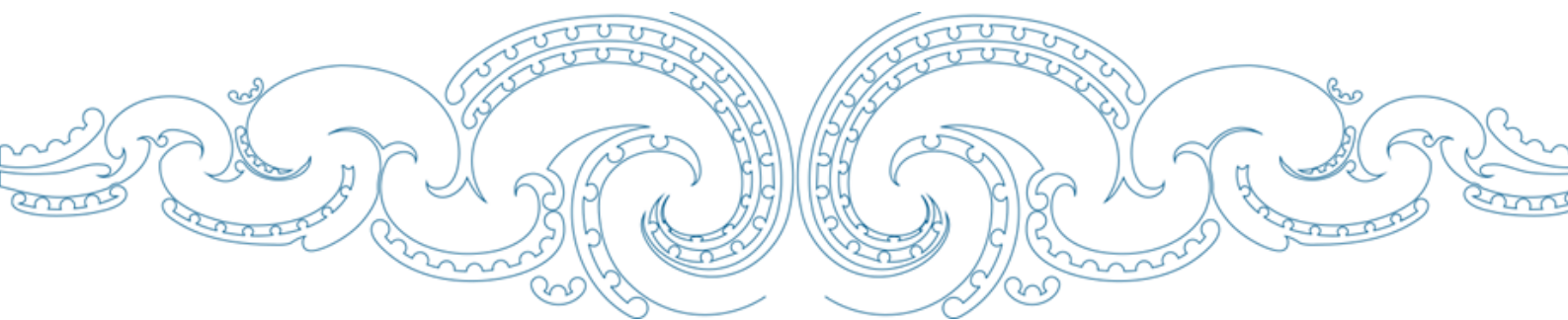


Why exhibit?

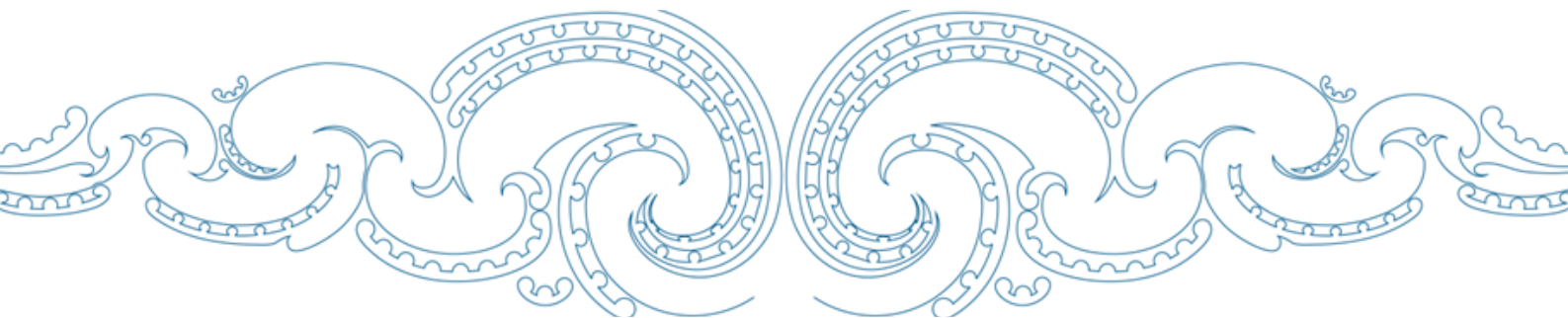

Terms and Conditions

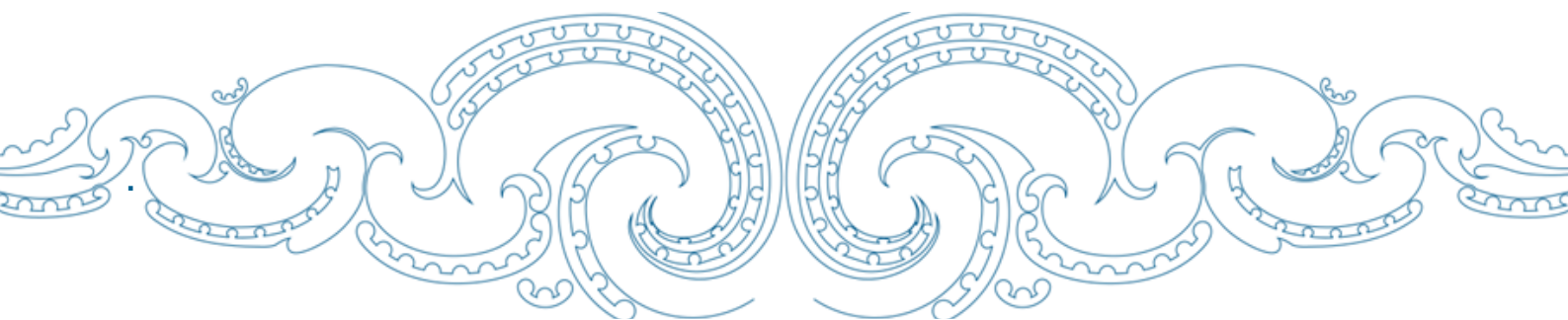
All prices are quoted in New Zealand dollars and exclude GST (Goods and Services Tax). GST of 15% will be applied to all exhibition packages.

Applications are by way of expression of interest to be considered for a stand at the ACC Rongoā Māori Conference. The event team will email within five working days to confirm if your application has been successful. Selection of exhibitors will be based on alignment to the kaupapa and to ensure we have a variety of stands.

Confirmation will be sent together with a tax invoice for the full amount and is payable within 20 days of the date of invoice (or prior to the conference, by arrangement). If payment is not made within this timeframe, your exhibition space may be offered to other exhibitors.

All payments should be made in New Zealand dollars by credit card or bank transfer. Credit card payments will be subject to 1.9% credit card fee. All payments must be received by the event organiser by 21 May 2024 to secure the assigned exhibition space.

If you wish to sell products from your exhibition space please advise on your application form. Please note no EFTPOS or cash float will be available and you are responsible for any payments and security.



Terms and Conditions

The Event Manager will confirm your booth allocation 4-6 weeks prior to the conference.

The Event Manager will consult with you if there are unexpected changes to the floorplan that may impact your exhibition space.

Exhibitors consent to their contact details being shared with conference suppliers and contractors.

CANCELLATION

All cancellations must be received in writing.

- Cancellations received prior to 1 May 2024 will be refunded in full.
- Cancellations received after 1 May 2024 will be refunded at 50% of the exhibition fee.

Non-payment does not constitute a cancellation.

The organisers reserve the right to cancel the exhibition due to events or circumstances beyond their control. In such a case, exhibitors will be refunded their full exhibition fees.
